Breast Cancer Surgery in Pennsylvania

This research brief looks at patients age 18 and older who underwent breast cancer surgery in a Pennsylvania general acute care hospital from calendar years 2008 to 2017, with emphasis on the most recent year of data, 2017. Breast cancer surgeries are defined as a record with a breast cancer diagnosis and a procedure for either full removal of the breast tissue, mastectomy, or partial removal of the breast tissue, lumpectomy.




The total number of breast cancer surgeries performed in Pennsylvania has stayed relatively consistent from 11,233 in 2008 to 11,717 in 2017.

In 2017, 71.0% of the breast cancer surgeries were lumpectomies, compared to 60.5% in 2008.

¹Includes a small number of breast cancer surgery cases (ranging from 31-55 cases each year) in which both lumpectomy and mastectomy were performed.




- There were **11,717** breast cancer surgeries in Pennsylvania in 2017.
- 93.7% of the patients (10,973) were Pennsylvania residents.
- 99.2% of the patients were female (11,627), and 0.8% (90) were male.
- 97.8% of all lumpectomy surgeries (8,129 out of 8,314) and 48.6% of all mastectomy surgeries (1,655 out of 3,403) were performed in an outpatient setting.





Breast Cancer Surgery Rates per 10,000 Female County Residents, 2017



Statewide, there were 20.8 breast cancer surgeries performed per 10,000 female residents in 2017.

- **By Age.** The rates for female residents aged 18-44 years, 45-64 years, 65-84 years and 85 years or older were 4.1, 27.9, 43.1, and 19.3, respectively.
- **By Poverty.** The rates were 13.7 for female residents living in high poverty areas (where 40% or more of the population lives in poverty) and 23.6 for female residents living in low poverty areas (where less than 10% of the population lives in poverty).
- **By Race/Ethnicity.** The rates for black (non-Hispanic), white (non-Hispanic), and Hispanic female residents were 19.8, 22.3, and 7.3, respectively.

Rate Calculations: Rates above included female residents age 18 and older and were calculated using PHC4 data and US Census Bureau data. Higher rates for some counties might be dependent on larger numbers of residents with high risk characteristics (e.g., age). County rates were not adjusted for these population differences so that important effects of these patient characteristics were not masked by such adjustment. Rates by poverty were based on Census 2016 estimates of poverty and population at the zip code level. The remainder of the rates above relied on Census 2017 population estimates at the county or state level.

About PHC4

Created by the PA General Assembly in 1986, the PA Health Care Cost Containment Council (PHC4) is an independent state agency charged with collecting, analyzing and reporting information that can be used to improve the quality and restrain the cost of health care in the state. PHC4 is governed by a 25-member board of directors, representing business, labor, consumers, health care providers, insurers and state government.
