

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Poisoning and Toxic Effects of Drugs, complicated	
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Key Findings

- Between 1999 and 2001, mortality decreased in 10 of the 11 procedure or treatment groups where three years of mortality data were available. The largest decrease was seen in patients admitted with Kidney Failure, where the mortality dropped from 11.3% in 1999 to 9.4% in 2001.
- In general, hospitals that had lower than expected mortality ratings in 2000 were more likely than other hospitals to continue to have lower than expected mortality ratings in 2001.
- Between 1999 and 2001, length of stay decreased in 9 of the 12 procedure or treatment groups where three years of length of stay data were available.
- There was wide variation in length of stay among hospitals. The condition with the most variation was Stomach and Small Intestinal Operations (complicated), where hospitals' average length of stay ranged from 6 to 18 days after taking patient risk factors into account. The state average was 10.8 days.
- There was also substantial variation among hospitals' readmission rates in 2001. For example, hospitals' 30-day risk-adjusted readmission rates for Congestive Heart Failure patients ranged from 9% to 47%. The state average was 25.4%.
- Among the conditions reported, Lung Infections (complicated) had the highest readmission
 rate for complications or infections at 8.2% and Poisoning and Toxic Effects of Drugs (complicated) had the lowest rate at 1.3%.
- The total charges for readmissions for complications or infections amounted to over \$300 million and almost 60,000 hospital days (for the conditions for which this measure was reported).

(Note: Key findings are based on statewide data from procedure and treatment groups reported in the printed version of the *Hospital Performance Report* and do not include data from the additional procedure and treatment groups reported on the Web site.)

Understanding this Report

Foreword

The Pennsylvania Health Care Cost Containment Council (PHC4) was established as an independent state agency by the General Assembly and Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in 1986. To help improve the quality and restrain the cost of health care, PHC4 promotes health care competition through the collection, analysis and public dissemination of uniform cost and quality-related information. Thanks to the vision of its General Assembly, Pennsylvania has begun to build a new health care marketplace where purchasers, consumers, providers, payors, and policy makers can make more informed decisions about the delivery of health care. This Hospital Performance Report is one of a series of public reports designed to achieve this goal, and is based on a previous PHC4 report, the Hospital Effectiveness Report, published from 1989 through 1994. What is the purpose of the report?

Before we make a major purchase, we normally familiarize ourselves with as much information as we can gather about the available products or services. By comparing what we can learn about the quality of the product as well as what will be charged for it, we decide on what we believe is the best quality product for the best possible price. It should be the same with health care services. Unfortunately, the information available to consumers and purchasers to make such decisions is limited and often not widely accessible. PHC4's *Hospital Performance Report* can help to fill that vacuum of information and assist consumers and purchasers in making more informed health care decisions. This report can also serve as an aid to providers in highlighting additional opportunities for quality improvement and cost containment. It should not be used in emergency situations.

What is new in this report?

New Clinical Conditions - Previous *Hospital Performance Reports* focused solely on Diagnosis Related Groups (DRGs). Twelve DRGs are included in this report. A Diagnosis Related Group (DRG) is an illness classification system adopted and modified by the federal government for standard health

care reporting and billing purposes by hospitals and insurance companies. The system groups similar medical conditions and surgical procedures into hundreds of illness categories, called DRGs, based on the patients' diagnoses and procedures.

In an effort to more precisely define clinical conditions, this report also includes 16 new conditions based on ICD-9-CM (International Classification of Diseases, Ninth Revision, Clinical Modification) codes, which specify the clinical reason(s) for a patient's hospitalization. Of the 16 code-based conditions, there are 7 diagnoses and 9 procedures. The addition of 16 code-based conditions enhances the ability of this report to compare patients that are most similar to each other clinically. Several of the conditions included in this report were previously included in the *Hospital Performance Report* as DRGs, but are now more clearly defined using ICD-9-CM codes. Descriptions of the code-based conditions and DRGs are on pages 10 and 11.

New Outcome Measures - This report also includes new outcome measures.


- The Length of Stay Outlier Rates (%) and Ratings provide a picture of abnormally short or long lengths of stay.
- The Percent of Cases Readmitted for Complications or Infections provides information about specific readmissions. In addition to reporting the percent of readmissions for any reason, this new measure focuses particularly on readmissions for complications or infection.

About this report

- This report, which covers inpatient hospital discharges during calendar year 2001, is divided into three regional versions. The information reported is hospital-specific.
- All Pennsylvania general and most specialty acute care hospitals, regardless of bed size, are included.
- The hospital names have been shortened in many cases for formatting purposes. Hospital names may be different today than in 2001 due to mergers and name changes. A list of changes can be found on the PHC4 Web site at www.phc4.org.

Where does the data come from?

Pennsylvania hospitals are required by law to submit certain information to PHC4. The 2001 data compiled for the purpose of this publication is reported as it was submitted to PHC4 by Pennsylvania hospitals. The data was subject to standard verification processes by PHC4. In addition, hospitals are required to submit data indicating in simple terms "how sick the patient was" or, in technical jargon, a "severity score." The data is then risk-adjusted.

Accounting for high-risk patients

Even though two patients may be admitted to the hospital with the same illness, there may be differences in the seriousness of their conditions. In order to report fair comparisons among hospitals, PHC4 uses a complex mathematical formula to "risk-adjust" the data, meaning that hospitals receive "extra credit" for treating patients that are more seriously ill or at a greater risk than others. Risk-adjusting the data is important because sicker patients may be more likely to die, stay in the hospital longer, or be readmitted.

The hospitals use a sophisticated patient risk classification system, called Atlas OutcomesTM, to assign patients to an appropriate illness category. Illness categories range from a patient who is not very sick to a patient who is near death. The Atlas OutcomesTM system was developed by MediQual Systems, Inc.®, a company of Cardinal Health Information Companies, and is based on the examination of numerous Key Clinical Findings such as lab tests, EKG readings, vital signs, patient's medical history, imaging results, pathology, age, sex, and operative/endoscopy findings. PHC4 also independently adjusts for other risk factors such as the presence of cancer and/or diabetes in the patient population included in this report.

What is measured in the report and why is it important?

PHC4's mission is to provide the public with information that will help to improve the quality of health care services while also providing opportunities to restrain costs. The measurement of quality in health care is not an exact science. There may be a number of ways to define quality; however, for the purposes of this report, six measures are suggested. (With the exception of volume of cases, each of these measures has been adjusted for patient risk. For more information, see the previous section entitled, *Accounting for high-risk patients*.)

• *Volume of Cases* – For each hospital, the number of cases in each code-based condition or DRG after exclusions is reported. This can give a patient or a purchaser an idea of the experience each facility has in treating such patients. Studies have suggested that in at least some areas, the volume of cases treated by a physician or hospital can be a factor in the success of the treatment.

The number of cases represents separate hospital admissions, not individual patients. A patient readmitted several times would be included each time in the number of cases. Hospitals that had fewer than five cases evaluated for risk-adjusted mortality were not rated; such low volume cannot be considered meaningful and, as such, the outcome data are excluded. *Not Reported* appears in the table next to these hospitals.

Note: Small or specialty hospitals may report low volume due to the unique patient population they serve or geographic location.

- *Risk-Adjusted Mortality* PHC4 has used risk-adjusted mortality statistics as a measure of quality since it began publishing reports in 1989. To determine the mortality rating, PHC4 compares the number of patients one could reasonably expect to die in a given hospital in a given codebased condition or DRG with the actual number of deaths.
- *Risk-Adjusted Length of Stay* The length of time a patient stays in the hospital can reflect how successful the hospital is in providing treatment and has an impact on the resources used in delivering treatment.

Understanding the Symbols

Symbols representing risk-adjusted mortality ratings and length of stay outlier ratings are displayed in the report. These symbols reflect a comparison of a hospital's actual rate and what is expected.

- O Signicantly lower than expected
- Not significantly different than expected
- Significantly higher than expected



• Risk-Adjusted Length of Stay Outlier Rates – Length of stay "outliers" are abnormally short or long hospitalizations – those individual hospitalizations where the difference between the actual and expected length of stay was in the top (long length of stay outliers) or bottom (short length of stay outliers) 5% of all statewide hospitalizations. They are the hospitalizations where the difference between the actual and expected length of stay was above or below the normal range for all hospitalizations in the state. For any one hospital, the outlier rate is the number of outliers divided by the total number of hospitalizations. Hospitals with low volume may have widely varying outlier rates even though there are only small differences between the numbers of outlier

cases. Take for example two hospitals that each have only 5 cases in a given condition. If one hospital has a single outlier case it would have a 20% outlier rate. However, a hospital with no outliers would have a 0% outlier rate. The length of stay outlier rating indicates whether the rate is significantly higher or lower than expected after taking the overall volume of cases in the condition/DRG into account.

Length of stay may be an important quality of care indicator; however, many factors affect length of stay, some of which are beyond the hospital's control. Abnormally short or long hospital stays may result from factors such as payor expectations, complications, or avoidable admissions due to inadequate health and social support in the community (see the *Technical Notes* on the PHC4 Web site, www.phc4.org, for a detailed description).

- Risk-Adjusted Readmissions, by Percent A readmission is defined as a subsequent acute care hospitalization, for any reason in any Pennsylvania hospital, where the admit date is within 30 days of the discharge date of the original hospitalization. While some rehospitalizations can be expected, high quality care may lessen the need for subsequent hospitalizations.
- Risk-Adjusted Readmissions for Complication/Infection, by Percent —
 The risk-adjusted readmission (discussed above) takes into consideration all subsequent hospitalizations within 30 days of the discharge date of the original hospitalization. However, this measure includes only readmissions with a principal diagnosis of a complication/infection.

Other Data Issues

- Do Not Resuscitate Cases The mortality analysis includes Do Not Resuscitate (DNR) cases.
- Not all data is reported for all measures. For example, lung cancer is a terminal illness where death is often the expected outcome; therefore, mortality and readmission rates are not meaningful measures of the quality of care and are not reported. Another example would be conditions or DRGs, such as Heart Attack Medical Management, where readmission rates are not reported because subsequent admissions are often planned. Hospital Charges

This report also includes the average hospital charge for each of the 16 code-based conditions and 12 DRGs. While charges are what the hospital reports on the billing form, they may not accurately represent the amount a hospital receives in payment for the services it delivers. Hospitals usually receive less in actual payments than the listed charge. However, charges are the only data compiled that reflect the relative cost of all services provided by hospitals. Consequently, hospital charges are used almost universally by those attempting to assess the costs of health care.

A look at the financial data submitted by hospitals to PHC4 can shed some light on the relationship between the amount hospitals charge or bill for services, and the amount they receive in Net Patient Revenue (NPR). According to PHC4's *Hospital Financial Analysis 2001*, *Volume One*, Pennsylvania hospitals received, on average statewide, \$.36 in NPR for every dollar that they charged in Fiscal Year 2001 (7/1/00 through 6/30/01).

Within the geographic area covered in this report, hospitals received, on average, \$.50 in NPR for every dollar charged. Broken down even further, hospitals within Northcentral Pennsylvania received, on average, \$.49 in NPR for every dollar charged, Southcentral Pennsylvania hospitals received an average of \$.55 on the dollar, and hospitals in Northeastern Pennsylvania received an average of \$.42 on the dollar.

These regional figures are aggregate only and cannot be applied to individual hospitals or individual average charges for code-based conditions or DRGs to calculate actual payment figures. This is due to substantial variation in hospital charges from hospital to hospital and from insurance product line to product line. There is also substantial variation in actual payments that hospitals receive for specific services. Actual payments to hospitals are imposed by Medicare and Medicaid, or result from negotiations with insurance companies, other third-party payors, and even individual patients.

How to use the report

- Patients/Consumers can use this report as an aid in making decisions about
 where to seek treatment for the categories detailed in this report. As with any
 health care decision, PHC4 urges the reader to use this report in conjunction
 with a physician or other health care provider when making a health care decision.
- Group Benefits Purchasers/Insurers can use this report as part of a process in determining where employees, subscribers, members, or participants should go for their health care.
- **Health Care Providers** can use this report as an aid in identifying opportunities for quality improvement and cost containment.
- Policy Makers/Public Officials can use this report to enhance their understanding of health care issues, to ask provocative questions, to raise public awareness of important issues and to help constituents identify quality health care options.
- All of the previously mentioned groups can use this information to raise important questions about why differences exist in the quality and efficiency of care.

This report can be used as a tool. It should not be used to generalize about the overall quality of care at a hospital, but instead to examine hospital performance in specific treatment categories. The measurement of quality is highly complex, and the information used to capture such measures is limited. A hospital death is frequently an unavoidable consequence of a patient's medical condition. Hospitals and physicians may do everything right and the patient can still die. However, the statistical methods used eliminate many of

the clinical and medical differences among the patients in different hospitals, thereby allowing us to explore the real differences in the measures presented in this report. The pursuit of these issues can play an important and constructive role in raising the quality while restraining the cost of health care in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.


Non-Compliant Hospitals

Hospitals are required under Pennsylvania law (Act 89) to submit timely, accurate health care data to PHC4. PHC4, acting upon the advice of its Technical Advisory Group, a panel of physicians and other health care experts, has determined that hospitals missing the required UB-92 data or patient severity scores in excess of or equal to 10% overall are non-compliant with state law and are excluded from this report. These hospitals are listed below. Hospitals that were non-compliant in 2001 but are currently compliant are so noted. Although hospitalization data specific to non-compliant hospitals is not shown in this report, these records have been included in the overall analysis for the measures included in this report, and thus are reflected in the statewide and regional totals.

Code-Based Diagnosis Descriptions

Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD):

Chronic lung disease where breathing is difficult due to airway narrowing, excess mucus production or inflammation. It is caused most frequently by bronchitis, asthma, or emphysema.

Congestive Heart Failure (CHF): Heart failure occurs when the heart loses its ability to pump enough blood through the body. Heart failure usually develops progressively over time as the heart gradually loses its pumping ability and works less efficiently.

Heart Attack – Medical Management: A heart attack (myocardial infarction) occurs when there is blockage or obstruction in the coronary arteries supplying blood to the heart. This results in damage or death to a part of the heart muscle. Included are heart attack patients who were treated without surgical interventions.

Pneumonia: Simple pneumonia (inflammation of the lung) includes viral and bacterial pneumonia, as well as pleurisy, an inflammation of the membrane surrounding the lungs.

Septicemia: Also know as blood poisoning, is a system-wide infection of the patient's blood. Does not include post-operative or post-injury infections.

Stroke – Hemorrhagic: Stroke is a cardiovascular disease that affects the blood vessels supplying blood to the brain. In hemorrhagic strokes, a blood vessel in the brain breaks or ruptures and causes bleeding (hemorrhage) within or around the brain.

Stroke – Non-hemorrhagic: In ischemic (non-hemorrhagic) strokes, a blood clot blocks a blood vessel in the brain or an artery leading to the brain. This is the most common type of stroke. Transient ischemic attack (temporary stroke symptoms) is not included.

Code-Based Procedure Descriptions

Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm Repair: An abdominal aortic aneurysm (AAA) is a bulge in the aorta (the aorta is the main blood vessel coming from the heart that supplies blood to all organs) in the abdomen. Does not include endovascular (minimally invasive graft technique) repairs or ruptured aneurysm repairs.

Gallbladder Removal – Laparoscopic: Cholecystectomy is the operation for removal of the gallbladder. Included are patients who underwent this type of surgery carried out with a laparoscope (microscopic camera) through 3 or 4 small incisions.

Gallbladder Removal – Open: Traditional gallbladder removal surgery that is carried out through an incision in the right side of the upper abdomen.

Colorectal Procedures: The majority of colorectal procedures are performed in relation to the presence of cancer or diverticulitis (inflammation of part of the lower digestive tract). Does not include patients with abdominal trauma.

Heart Attack – Angioplasty/Stent: Treatment (called percutaneous translumial coronary angioplasty or PTCA) of a heart attack using special balloons to open up obstructed arteries and increase blood flow to the heart. Often, a stent (a mesh tube) is inserted in the blocked or narrowed artery to open it wider and prevent renarrowing or recurring blockage. Does not include coronary artery bypass graft surgery (CABG).

Hysterectomy – Abdominal: A hysterectomy is an operation, performed through an abdominal incision, to remove the uterus (womb) and sometimes the ovaries and fallopian tubes. This type of surgery is performed when vaginal or laparoscopic approaches are deemed inappropriate for a variety of conditions including female cancers, uterine fibroids, endometriosis, pelvic trauma, and uterine or vaginal prolapse.

Hysterectomy – Vaginal: Includes hysterectomy through a vaginal approach and those laparoscopically (use of microscopic camera) assisted. Includes hysterectomy performed for a variety of conditions such as female cancers, pelvic trauma, uterine fibroids, and endometriosis.

Prostatectomy – Radical: Radical prostatectomy is the surgical removal of the entire prostate. This type of surgery is usually performed when localized cancer is present.

Prostatectomy – Transurethral: This type of surgery involves the surgical removal of part of the prostate gland and is usually done to relieve urinary symptoms caused by benign (non-cancerous) enlargement of the prostate.

Diagnosis Related Group (DRG) Descriptions

Blood Clot in Lung (DRG 078): Often called a pulmonary embolism, this is a blockage in the lung usually due to a blood clot. May be caused by fat or an air bubble.

Lung Infections, complicated (DRG 079): Infections other than simple pneumonia including tuberculosis, pneumonitis, and certain rare pneumonias.

Lung Cancer (DRG 082): Includes the initial diagnosis, as well as follow-up care, for patients with cancerous and non-cancerous tumors. Does not include chemotherapy.

Vascular Disorders, Except Heart, complicated (DRG 130): Medical treatment for disorders of blood vessels in the head, neck, aorta, upper and lower limbs. Examples include varicose veins, aneurysm, and diabetes related circulatory disorders. Conditions not included are hypertension and coronary artery disease.

Abnormal Heartbeat, complicated (DRG 138): Abnormal heart rate or rhythm including tachycardia, bradycardia, fibrillation, flutter and heart block. Does not include heart attack, congenital heart defects, or heart valve disorders.

Stomach & Small Intestinal Operations, complicated (DRG 154): Surgical procedures on the esophagus, stomach, and small intestine. Does not include removal of appendix.

Stomach and Intestinal Bleeding, complicated (DRG

174): Bleeding from stomach or intestinal ulcers, inflammation of the stomach, or inflammation of small sac-like areas in the wall of the colon.

Hip Operations Except Replacement, complicated (**DRG 210**): Includes surgery for hip fracture. Does not include replacements or amputations.

Diabetes (DRG 294): Includes patients over age 35 hospitalized for control of blood sugar. Conditions include coma, ketoacidosis, and fluid imbalances. Kidney, eye, nervous system, or circulatory complications related to diabetes are not included.

Kidney Failure (DRG 316): Short and long-term kidney (renal) failure due to hypertension, heart disease, or unknown causes. Does not include dialysis or transplants.

Kidney & Urinary Tract Infections, complicated (**DRG 320**): Acute and chronic infections of the kidney and urinary tract. Does not include urinary stone or urinary symptoms such as frequency, bleeding, or pain.

Poisoning & Toxic Effects of Drugs, complicated (DRG 449): Toxic effects of overdose, wrong substance given or substance taken in error. Medications, non-medical substances such as pestisides, drugs such as ethyl alcohol and heroin, metals, and gases such as carbon monoxide are included. Does not include drug abuse or dependency.


