


# **Key Findings & Statewide Statistics**

## **Coronary Artery Bypass Graft (CABG)**

## Number of Cases




CY 2019 – CY 2021 data are displayed for trending purposes only and are not included in the report analyses.



There were **16,869** hospitalizations for coronary artery bypass graft (CABG) procedures performed in Pennsylvania acute care hospitals during Calendar Years (CY) 2022 and 2023.

Of these hospitalizations, **13,483** cases, after exclusions, were examined in the Hospital Results section of this report in determining statewide rates of mortality, readmission and postoperative length of stay.



Percentages may not add to 100% due to rounding.

### **Mortality**

- The in-hospital mortality rate was **1.3%**.
- Patients aged 85 and older had the highest mortality rate at **4.7%**.
- Black (non-Hispanic) patients had a mortality rate of 1.7%, White (non-Hispanic) patients had a mortality rate of 1.3% and Hispanic patients had a mortality rate of 1.2%.
- Female patients had a mortality rate of **2.3%** and male patients had a mortality rate of **1.1%**.

## Readmission

- **4.1%** of patients were readmitted to an acute care hospital within 7 days, **9.7%** were readmitted within 30 days, and **14.8%** were readmitted within 90 days.
- Black (non-Hispanic) patients had the highest 30-day readmission rate at **13.9%**. Hispanic and White (non-Hispanic) patients had 30-day readmission rates of **11.0%** and **9.5%**, respectively.
- Female patients had a 30-day readmission rate of **12.6%** and male patients had a readmission rate of **8.9%**.

## **Postoperative Length of Stay**

- In CY 2022-2023, patients stayed in the hospital an average of **6.3** days following a CABG procedure.
- **3.8%** of patients experienced an extended postoperative length of stay; that is, after accounting for patient risk, they stayed in the hospital longer than expected. The average postoperative stay for these patients was **20.3** days.

## **Medicare Payments**

- The average Medicare fee-for-service payment for hospitalizations in CY 2022-2023 was **\$41,480**.
- The average Medicare fee-for-service payment for hospitalizations with an extended postoperative length of stay was **\$80,946**.

Rate calculations: Hospitalization rates above were based on Pennsylvania residents (15,218 hospital stays or 90.2% of all 16,869 hospitalizations for CABG) using PHC4 discharge data and 2023 US Census Bureau population figures.

High Poverty rates included hospitalizations for residents living in areas where 20% or more of the population lives in poverty.

*Rural County* and *Urban County* rates were based on the designation of the county of residence as defined by The Center for Rural Pennsylvania. Urban counties are italicized in the following list of counties by region. Regional rates were adjusted for population differences in age and sex.

- Western PA includes the following counties: *Allegheny*, Armstrong, *Beaver*, Bedford, Blair, Butler, Cambria, Cameron, Clarion, Clearfield, Crawford, Elk, *Erie*, Fayette, Forest, Greene, Indiana, Jefferson, Lawrence, McKean, Mercer, Potter, Somerset, Venango, Warren, Washington, and *Westmoreland*.
- Central & Northeastern PA includes the following counties: Adams, Bradford, Centre, Clinton, Columbia, *Cumberland, Dauphin*, Franklin, Fulton, Huntingdon, Juniata, *Lackawanna, Lancaster, Lebanon, Luzerne*, Lycoming, Mifflin, Monroe, Montour, Northumberland, Perry, Pike, Snyder, Sullivan, Susquehanna, Tioga, Union, Wayne, Wyoming, and *York*.
- Southeastern PA includes the following counties: Berks, Bucks, Carbon, Chester, Delaware, Lehigh, Montgomery, Northampton, Philadelphia, and Schuylkill.
