Special Data Requests Update

New Council Member Appointments

PHC4 welcomes three new members to its Council, Representative Bryan Cutler, Ms. Jodi Frantz, and Mr. Neal Lesher.

Representative Bryan Cutler represents the 100th Legislative District in the Pennsylvania House of Representatives, serving part of Lancaster County, and is the Republican Leader for the House. Representative Cutler joins Senator Camera Bartolotta and Representative Dan Frankel in filling three of the four General Assembly positions required by PHC4's enabling legislation, Act 15 of 2020.

Ms. Jodi Frantz, Chief of Staff at the Pennsylvania Insurance Department, was named as the designee for Acting Insurance Commissioner, Michael Humphreys. Governor Shapiro authorized Ms. Frantz as the representative.

Mr. Neal Lesher, Director of Government Affairs for the Pennsylvania Chamber of Business and Industry, was appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Kim Ward, as the new business representative on the Council. Mr. Lesher replaced the recently retired Mr. Gene Barr.

PHC4 Data Users Series

Estimating the Burden of RSV Infection

Dr. Mary Patricia Nowalk, Professor at the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine and colleagues used PHC4 data to estimate the hospitalization and economic burden of adults hospitalized with infections due to respiratory syncytial virus (RSV). From this research, published in the scholarly journal *Vaccine*, these investigators suggest the age- and risk group-specific findings and economic burden estimates could help inform health care planning and resource allocation and in prioritizing RSV vaccination policy, especially for population subgroups found to be disproportionately affected.

Dr. Nowalk noted the high value of PHC4 data because it contained the variables that enabled her team to perform subgroup analyses and to analyze the economic burden across patient groups.

This report provides hospitalspecific results for five cardiac procedures: coronary artery bypass graft (CABG), percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) for patients who had a heart attack, PCI for patients who did not have a heart attack, surgical aortic valve replacement (SAVR), and transcatheter aortic valve

replacement (TAVR). The analysis is based on hospitalization data from January 2020 through December 2021. County-level hospitalization rates for each procedure are also included.
